

# Financial Development



#### **Administration**

- Adjusted GEMT standard with state auditor to not include investments as revenue to offset Medi-Cal expenses (\$25,000 savings).
- Negotiated new, fiscally sustainable four-year organized labor contract with USW/TEMSA 12911.

#### **Finance**

- Collected \$920k in Overdue Mitigation Fees.
- Collected \$95k COVID Loss Insurance Claim.
- Improved Clinic's All Inclusive Rate (AIR) by 36% and received \$600k in Retro Payments.
- Invested excess cash in high-yield interestearning accounts, netting \$82,000.
- Secured county partnership to cover any Urgent Care Operating losses.




